

Regular Substantive Interaction (RSI)

The Department of Education has ruled that courses must foster regular substantive interaction (RSI). If you are not in a face-to face classroom, this can be accomplished via videoconferencing tools and the types of assignments you choose. These are some of the assignment formats that you can use with instructions on how to create them.
