How to enable BioSig on a quiz or exam with a click of a button

1. Locate your quiz or exam link and click the setting button "..." on the right, then select "Edit":

How to restrict access to a content item/folder using BioSig

In addition to quizzes and exams, BioSig can be used to restrict access to any content item such an assignment or folder in your course.

In this example, we will show you how to restrict Lesson 1 using BioSig instance.

Part 1: How to create a BioSig instance for Lesson 1

1. Navigate to the course Content page, click the "+" icon, then select "Content Market":



2. Select "Biometric Signature ID Deeplink":
